General Information & Requirements

- Scholarships totaling \$10,000 will be split and granted to eight (8) applicants.
 - a. Recipients are chosen based on a culmination of merit, financial need, and community involvement.
 - b. Scholarships of \$2,000 will be awarded to each of the top two (2) applicants; \$1,000 will be awarded to each of remaining six (6) applicants
- Family members of Jai Lao Foundation officers and directors are not eligible to apply.
- Applicant must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Applicant must be a descendant from Laos
- Applicant must be an
 - a. High School Senior/First-time College/Uni Freshman accepted for Fall 2023
 - b. Current college/Uni freshman/sophomore enrolled for Fall 2023

Please submit an essay on one of the topics listed below. Your essay should be 500-750 words in length, double spaced, and 12 point font.

Option #1: One of the purposes of this scholarship is to promote Lao culture and heritage. Choose an aspect of your culture/heritage that has greatly impacted your development. Describe how you plan to use your cultural background to achieve your educational goals and contribute to the preservation of Lao culture and heritage.

Option #2: By investing in our youths through the gift of education, we are growing a generation of scholars with great minds and giving hearts. What are your academic and professional goals? Describe any adversity or challenges you have had to overcome in pursuit of these goals. How do you plan to utilize your education to achieve a better future for you, your family, and the Lao community?

Option #3: It is our hope that through this program we can recognize and reward the students who are determined to build a strong cultural foundation to strengthen and illuminate the Lao community. Are there any needs or problems with the Lao community that you hope to address with your education? How have you contributed to addressing these needs?

Option #4: Tell us what you'd like us to know about you. What about your unique personal background, identity, traits, interest, or talents are going to enhance your education, future employment, and ability to positively impact your local community?
